We ran a successful Try Sailing Day, mostly publicized by Nola. We had 20 students in Learn to Sail which ran for 8 weeks with 6-7 Bics, 3-4 Pacers, 2 small catamarans and occasionally trailer sailors. We had lots of support and help from our club members which made the course a great success. The Active Kids Program provided school age children vouchers to use for a sport of their choice. Half of the children paid with vouchers which was a good way to help families to afford lessons.

Our Pacer Series was a good event with consistent crew throughout. The trophy was kindly donated by Julie Ferguson. We plan to continue this event.

We joined Australian Sports Foundation which allows members to donate to club as a tax deduction. This allowed Ned to donate 2 x Nacra 350 Catamarans to our club.

Another incentive – book through Wotif and 5% will be donated to our club (you need to give them a special code).

Ian Mitchie mentioned we may not given tax receipts for donations. Norm said we did have a problem with this and is now sorted. Apologies to all concerned.

Rescue boat purchased – applied for a grant.

Sold old rescue boat with new trailer. Purchased an old trailer and Chris modified in the interim.

We finished changerooms over 2 years which was a mammoth project - success!

We plan to purchase a new fence to match the new pool fence next door.
